



Stephanie Cohen Independent Arbitrator

Stephanie Cohen is an independent arbitrator of international and domestic commercial disputes, based in New York City. She is admitted to practice law in New York and Ontario, Canada, and is a Canadian citizen.

Stephanie is a member of the ICDR/AAA International Panel of Arbitrators and has served as tribunal chair, sole arbitrator, and emergency arbitrator in disputes under the ICC Rules. Prior to establishing her practice as an arbitrator, Stephanie was Counsel at White & Case LLP in New York, where she was a member of the Firm's pre-eminent international arbitration practice. As counsel, Stephanie regularly advised clients on the drafting of dispute resolution clauses and represented clients in both ad hoc and administered international arbitrations, including arbitrations under the ICC Rules, the ICDR Rules, and the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules, and in matters involving bilateral investment treaties. She also acted as counsel in domestic arbitrations governed by the AAA Commercial Arbitration Rules and represented clients in high profile litigation matters before U.S. federal and state courts.

Stephanie is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators and was a member of the ICDR subcommittee that revised the ICDR International Arbitration Rules in 2014. She is also an active member of the New York and Canadian international arbitration communities, serving on the International Commercial Disputes Committee of the New York City Bar Association and the Advisory Board of Young Canadian Arbitration Practitioners, and as Co-Chair of ICC Canada's Annual International Arbitration Conference. Stephanie also serves on the ICC Commission on Arbitration and ADR's Task Force on Emergency Arbitrator Proceedings.
